Description:

As an intern in the Integrated Advisory Team (IAT), Innovation Management Cell at HQ JFC Brunssum you will be required to provide assistance in the field of Innovation Development.

About the internship:

During this 6 months programme, starting 2 February 2026 until 31 July 2026, you will be expected to further develop the JFCBS innovation and transformation system and governance capability to support the Joint Warfighting HQ transformation programme. You will be required to support the maturity of JFCBSs engagement and contribution to the NATO Innovation Network to further develop the Innovation Management system that supports the processes, procedures and resources required for JFCBS to be an effective operator in this area.

The intern must:

- **for the whole period of the internship be enrolled and studying for a Bachelor's or Master's degree in the field of Innovation Management, Change Management, Business Processes or Artificial Intelligence or similar;**

In addition, we are looking for candidates having the following desirable skills:

- be able to effectively plan and organize.
- strong computer skills (e.g. ECDL) including use of Microsoft Office package and experience working with relational databases;
- good knowledge of ideation/innovation project and programme management tools;
- be dynamic, self-motivated and able to work in a team environment with people from diverse backgrounds.

Stipend:

You will be compensated at a fixed taxable rate of € 1424.59 (2025 rates), per month based on 37.5 hours internship work hours per week.

We will also compensate you for travel costs to/from university to HQ JFC Brunssum (within set cap rates).

Interns will be entitled to 2 days of leave for each full month (of 37.5 hours a week) of internship.
